



A Congregational Shomrei Trip with Rabbi George  
**New Mexico's Conversos and Crypto-Jews  
in Santa Fe, New Mexico**

In 1492, the Alhambra Decree forced Spain's Jewish citizens to make an unthinkable decision: convert to Christianity or leave the country. Over the next 500 years, the conversos and Crypto-Jews, who practiced their faith in secrecy, traveled to the New World and finally to New Mexico, where their traditions melded with those of the people of the Southwest. The trip will take us to this land of canyons and desert, where we will trace the struggle of New Mexico's conversos and Crypto-Jews and consider how their traditions have managed to survive against the odds.

### Trip Includes

- 5 nights at a 4-star hotel in Santa Fe
- 12 meals (5 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 4 dinners)
- 4 expert-led lectures, 5 expert-led field trips and 1 performance
- A group leader, along with Rabbi George, to accompany us throughout
- The sense of shared experience that's common to all CST trips!

### Cost

- With 27 travelers, cost of double occupancy: \$1249. Single Occupancy: \$1699. Air not included. Limit 30 people.
- **Deposit of \$100 is due by September 1, 2017.** Final payment is due March 15, 2018.

### Road Scholar Cancellation Policy

- Cancel up to 120 days prior to trip: \$50
- 119 days to 56 days prior: \$100
- 55 to 14 days prior: \$200
- Fewer than 14 days prior 50%
- Non-attendance: 100% if you don't call Road Scholar
